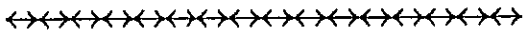


The regular meeting of the Crescent Outlaws was called to order at 7:00 PM with 27 members present.

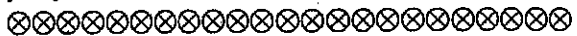
WEB SITE
